

A) Lumsdale Falls – the MOST atmospheric waterfall in the Peak District A stunning, historic waterfall nestled in the ruins of old mills.

Postcode: DE4 5NA A Nearest Car Park: Lumsdale, Matlock Prip: Wear sturdy footwear—some paths can be slippery. Explore the historic mill ruins for a fascinating glimpse into the area's industrial past.

B) Padley Gorge – A National Trust site
Walk through the ancient woodlands and enjoy the mixed habitats, on this 2.3 mile walk

Postcode: S32 2JA A Nearest Car Park: Longshaw Estate Car Park (S11 7TZ) Prip: A great spot for a picnic! If visiting in autumn, expect stunning golden foliage.

C) Middle Black Clough Waterfall – a challenging walking route Easy to park, cross a bridge and follow the river. Cross over stepping stones and access the waterfall. Walk behind the huge waterfall to cool off in the Summer.

Postcode: SK13 1JE (near Woodhead Reservoir) A Nearest Car Park: Layby on A628 near Woodhead Reservoir Tip: Prepare for a short but adventurous hike. Waterproof boots are recommended due to stream crossings.

D) Kinder Downfall – Iconic and completely freezes over in Winter
Absolutely stunning walk, very tough but 100% worth the effort for the rewarding and breath taking waterfall

- Postcode: SK22 2LJ (Bowden Bridge Car Park) A Nearest Car Park: Bowden Bridge Car Park Park: Best visited after heavy rainfall when the waterfall is at its most dramatic. Strong winds can blow the water upwards!
- E) Three Shires Head Lovely route with a scenic waterfall A bit over 4 miles, takes you out to Three Shires Head and back. Taking in secluded river valleys, mature woodland
- Postcode: SK11 0BD (Clough House Car Park) 🖨 Nearest Car Park: Clough House Car Park 🕏 Tip: A fantastic spot for wild swimming in summer. The historic packhorse bridge adds to the charm.
- F) Waterfall Swallet An unknown hidden gem along the side of the road between Foolow and Eyam Head down the steps into a wooded gorge. You'll hear the waterfall before you see it
- Postcode: S32 5AD (near Eyam) A Nearest Car Park: Layby on Foolow Road Tip: This waterfall is seasonal—visit after rainfall for the best experience. The descent into the gorge can be slippery.
- G) Monsal Dale Weir Running along the former Midland Railway line The official Monsal trail is 8.5 miles long, stretching at its furthest points between Blackwell Mill in Chee Dale and Coombs Road in Bakewell.
- Postcode: DE45 1NL (Monsal Head) 🚇 Nearest Car Park: Monsal Head Car Park 📝 Tip: A short, scenic walk leads to the weir. Enjoy views of the famous Headstone Viaduct from Monsal Head viewpoint.
